10 Game Marathon 9 Pin No-Tap Tournament

Rules

1. Tournament will be held Sunday, September 27th at 9:00 AM at Eastmont Lanes in East Wenatchee, WA.
2. Teams must be one adult male and one adult female. A minimum of 20 teams is required to hold the tournament. Tournament will be limited to 32 teams.
3. Team average must add up to 420 or less. Average will be based on 2025-26 high book with at least 21 games. Certified summer leagues will be considered acceptable averages. Bowlers with only a Sport League average will use USBC conversion chart but must have a book average of at least 21 games from 25-26 season. If a bowler has no book average from the 25-26 season, bowlers may still enter the tournament; males bowl with a 215 average and females with a 185 average.
4. Handicap will be 90% of 220 for all bowlers.
5. Entry fee: \$140.00 per team, \$60.00 lineage, \$80.00 prize fund. An additional \$1,000.00 to the prize fund has been donated by Johnson Electric. Entry fee includes all bowling and lunch during break. First 32 pre-paid teams will be accepted. Full entry fee must accompany entry form to be considered reserved. Spots will not be held without payment and entries with only half the fee attached will not be accepted.
6. Prize ratio is 1:4.
7. All games will be bowled using a 9 pin no-tap format.
8. Teams bowl 5 games, break for lunch, then bowl 5 more.
9. Teams will draw for starting pair and skip a pair after 2 games, except for the last 2 games which will be one pair to the right. For example: Start on 1&2, then 5&6, 9&10, 13&14, finish on 15 & 16. This format ensures no team will bowl on the same pair twice.
10. Optional side brackets will be available. After the winners have been paid, the rest of the funds will be donated to the Sunshine League, a local non-profit organization that coordinates a bowling league for bowlers with special needs.
11. Teams unable to complete 10 games will not receive refunds.
12. Lanes will be oiled prior to first set of five games only.
13. Check-in starts at 8:00 a.m., practice at 8:45 a.m., and competition at 9:00 a.m.
14. Cancellations made at least 48 hours before the tournament start time will be refunded 50% of the entry fee. Cancellations made less than 48 hours before the tournament start time will not be refunded.
15. Any disputes or other decisions will be addressed by tournament director.
